## Facilities



### Shoryu Waterfall

This 9-meter waterfall was selected as one of the Shikoku 88 View Spots. The water gushing out and down the falls is a highlight of this "waterfall."



### Lawn Area

Approximately four-hectare large-sized green grass carpet. Visitors can enjoy the seasonal flowers in the surrounding flower gardens.



### Tatsu-No-Ko Square

The "Fluffy Dome" and various other playground equipment are scattered throughout the play spot.

The park boasts a spacious lawn, playground equipment that is popular for children along with cycling courses, auto campgrounds, and more.



### X Slide

Visitors can enjoy the two ultra long roller slides (approx. 60 m) as well as the rope climbing wall and other playground equipment.



### Cycling Course

A six-km course which goes around the park. Visitors can rent bicycles from the Rental Bicycle Center (for an additional fee).



### Restaurant & Souvenir Shops

In addition to the restaurant where visitors can enjoy a meal, there are places to purchase snacks and souvenirs.



## Campground "Hotto Stay Manno"



Visitors can enjoy the four seasons at the campgrounds. Visitors can stay at either the tent sites or the lodgings with air conditioning. (Please note: the staff can only speak Japanese)

### Manno Pond

From the Manno Pond View Walkway, located inside the park, visitors can see Manno Pond, the largest agricultural reservoir in Japan where the monk Kukai once practiced.



## Nearby Tourist Spots



### A Kotohira-gu Shrine

The God of the Sea has been affectionately referred to as "Konpira-san" since ancient times. After climbing the 785 stone steps to the top, visitors are rewarded with a magnificent view of the Sanuki Plains. (picture provided by Kotohira-gu Shrine)



### B Sohonzan Zentsuji Temple

The monk Kobo Daishi built this temple himself over a period of six years beginning in the year 807. This temple is number 75 on the Shikoku 88 Holy Places pilgrimage. (picture provided by Sohonzan Zentsuji Temple)



### C Marugame Castle

Rich with over 400 years of history, this castle boasts the tallest stone walls in Japan. Being "one of the 12 remaining wooden castle towers," the castle tower is also the smallest in Japan. (picture provided by Marugame City)



### D Chichibugahama Beach

Chichibugahama Beach is one of Japan's famous sunset spots. Visitors may experience the mirror-like scenery at low tide, when the tide pools reflect the sky. (picture provided by Mitoyo Tourism and Exchange Authority)

## Great access! A tourist attraction with everything easily accessible in a compact area.

Kagawa Prefecture is Japan's smallest prefecture, land-wise. Picturesque tourist spots such as Kotohira-gu Shrine, Zentsuji Temple, Chichibugahama Beach, Marugame Castle, Seto Ohashi Bridge, and so on, are all accessible within one hour by car from the park. It is also recommended to visit other parts of Shikoku and Okayama Prefecture.

### ACCESS

**By Car** / From Hiroshima/Okayama: approx. 35 mins from Sakaide IC on the Seto-Chuo Expressway  
From Ehime/Kochi: approx. 25 mins from Zentsuji IC on the Takamatsu Expressway  
From Tokushima: approx. 40 mins from Mima IC on the Tokushima Expressway  
From Takamatsu Airport: approx. 30 mins

**By Train** / From JR Kotohira Station / Kotoden-Kotohira Station / Okada Station: approx. 15 mins by bus or taxi
