



## ACCESS TO PARK



CAR · About 35 min. from Sakaide IC of Setochuo Expressway (From Hiroshima or Okayama Area)  
· About 25 min. from Zentsuji IC of Takamats Expressway (From Ehime or Kochi Area)  
· About 40 min. from Mima IC of Tokushima Expressway (From Tokushima Area)



RAIL ROAD · About 15 min by taxi from JR Kotohira Station, Kotoden Kotohira Station or Kotoden Okada Station.  
BUS · Get a bus bound for "Miai, Mikado, Ochai-Bashi and Kawaoku" from JR Kotohira-ekimae Bus Stop or Kotoden Kotohira-ekimae Bus Stop. Get off at "Mannou-Koen-Guchi". About 30 min on foot.

○Children ages five and under are admitted free. Purchasing a ticket for a senior will require documents that will prove the person's age like health insurance or other identification cards.  
○Holder of Disability or Rehabilitation Certificates and one accompanying helper will be admitted free by presenting any of the said certificates.  
○Group should be 20 or more of elementary students or older. (Including visitors with annual passport or the above certificate holders)  
○Annual Passports are available at the Administration Center. It is valid for one year from the date of purchase.

○Large Size Vehicle: Total vehicle body weight over 8t, maximum load over 5t, or riding capacity of more than 30.  
○Free parking will be given if the driver or fellow passenger holds and could present a Physical Disability Certificate or Rehabilitation Certificate. (In case of more than 11 passengers, 2 of them are required to present their certificates).  
○Adults or seniors with annual passports are given discounted parking fee. Normal Car: ¥250; Motorcycle: ¥80

## Shoryu Waterfall

At the end of the vista is a giant 9-meter-high artificial waterfall featuring a vertical stone works with climbing dragon at the center. The highlight of this attraction is the forceful splashing and squirting of water of about 65tons/min.

## Rental Bicycle Center
